For new students applying to CTC for the School Year 2026-2027:

- Please complete the online application that is located on your high school's website or the Lebanon County CTC's website. Please click the correct link for your high school for the online application.
- Please fill in your demographics with typing in your **full legal name**. Please select your first program of choice at the CTC.
- When completing the information for parent/guardian please be sure to enter the name of
 your parent/guardian in those text boxes. At first it only has one section for parent/guardian
 if you wish to add additional parent/guardian/emergency contact please click the green plus
 sign to the right of that section.
- Once you have completed all sections you will select the submit button at the bottom right of the page. The application is then submitted to your high school counseling department to complete some additional information.
- Once that information is completed by the school, it will then be submitted to the Lebanon County CTC.
- Email notifications will be sent to the email that is provided in the application on when it is submitted to your high school and then submitted to the CTC.
- The application deadline for the school year 2026-2027 is March 2, 2026.

Around March 17, 2026, CTC will begin accepting students into the programs and email notifications will be sent out. Approximately in the beginning of June, emails will be sent to parents/guardians and students from the CTC to congratulate them on being accepted to their program with additional important information.

Any student who is enrolled in a CTC program currently or has attended CTC at any point in the last few years and would like to apply to the CTC for a new program, DOES NOT complete an online application. We asked that you see your High School Counselor or contact the Lebanon County CTC Counselor's office for a paper application that will need to be completed by the March 2, 2026, deadline.
