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Cosmetology

Program Description: A program that generally prepares individuals to cut, trim, and style scalp, facial, and body hair; apply cosmetic preparations; perform manicures and pedicures; massage the head and extremities; and prepare for practice as licensed cosmetologists in specialized or full-service salons. Includes instruction in hair cutting and styling, manicuring, pedicuring, facial treatments, shampooing, chemical applications, esthetics, shop management, sanitation and safety, customer service, and applicable professional and labor laws and regulations

Half- Day Year One and Full Day Year Two

Year One: Half-Day 8:00am – 10:25am (36 weeks – 3 credits)

Year Two: Full-Day 8:00am – 2:00pm (36 weeks – 7.5 credits)

Cosmetology Tools & Equipment

The following is a list of tools and equipment that students will receive instruction on:

• Mannequins and mannequin stands • Haircutting shears and texturizing shears • Clippers and trimmers • Razors and razor cutting tools • Combs and brushes • Blow dryers • Flat irons • Curling irons and wands • Hot rollers and roller sets • Hair rollers and perm rods • Perm waving equipment and supplies • Hair color bowls, brushes, applicator bottles, and measuring tools • Hair Color processing equipment • Foils and highlighting tools • Shampoo bowls and shampooing equipment	• Styling stations and mirrors • Facial steamers • Facial implements and equipment • Brow waxing equipment and supplies • Nail manicure equipment and implements • Nail files, buffers, and nail tools • Nail polish and nail service equipment • Towels, capes, drapes, and protective coverings • Sanitation and disinfection equipment • Barbicide/disinfectant containers • First-aid and safety equipment • Personal protective equipment (PPE) • Salon/clinic equipment and workstations
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Grading Scale

The LCCTC grading system incorporates three components: competencies (skill— 33.3%), career skills (work ethic— 33.3%), and theory (knowledge—33.3%). Each academic class implements a performance evaluation/student grading system that incorporates career skills (work ethic), and theory (knowledge). Each component is weighted equally.

Progress Reports

Students will receive a “Progress Report” each mid-quarter through the mail for any student with a 70% or less, and a “Report Card” will be given to each student at the end of each quarter. It is the student's responsibility to share this information with their parents/guardians. Both reports will utilize student performance data obtained from competencies, career skills, and theory grades.

Please Note: 40% is the minimum grade for the first 3 marking periods. However, students with excessive absences may be assigned an earned grade with administrative approval. There is no minimum grade for the 4th marking period.
